- Coloring books** with **non-toxic crayons and markers** to bring out the artist in them.
- Picture books** to let their imagination go wild.
- Familiar items** such as a stuffed animal or a blanket to soothe them during scary times.
- Favorite foods, snacks, and drinks**, especially if your child is on a special diet.
- Noise-cancelling headphones or ear plugs** to keep all those loud noises away from your child's ears.
- Any medical id cards, tags, bracelets**, etc. in case of emergencies.
- Supplements/medications** to keep them healthy and ready to go.
- Child's favorite sheets**, especially if your child is sensitive to certain fabrics.
